**September 22, 2009 • Les femmes et la maternité dans l'œuvre de deux artistes canadiens-argentins.**

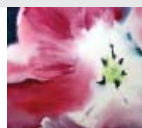
Welcome back from a summer of gathering inspiration. Presenter: **Éléonora Secco-Dufault** formerly an Art Gallery owner in South America.
