Arteast Official Rules

Incomplete entries or entries not satisfying these Official Rules will not be accepted.

1. Works will be delivered and picked up as arranged through one of the Art Curator. The art curator will be responsible for displaying and removing the art works.
2. The Art Curator will do everything possible to maintain the quality of the works while they are on the their premises.
3. Works must be dry, suitably framed and matted (where appropriate) and ready to display on an easel. Inappropriate or poorly framed or presented works may be refused at the discretion of the art curator.
4. Works on paper must be matted in white, off-white or neutral colours, framed and wired ready for hanging. Glass with clips but no frame is not accepted. Works on unframed canvas must have the staples on the back and the edges finished in a professional manner. Works must not exceed the diagonal measurements specified for each exhibit. Entries must not be copies, derivatives, or based in any way on other copyrighted paintings or photographs. Entries must not have been created under instruction. Artists must ensure their work is available and for sale once it has been accepted to the show.
5. Photography- All submitted Images must be the fully original creations of the entrants, must be the sole work of the entrants and all persons, places and/or objects appearing within all submitted Images and requiring release for trade or advertising uses must have been fully and properly released. By entering, all entrants agree to grant the Arteast and sponsors the right to use their Images on Arteast web site(s) and in any publicity or promotions for future Arteast photo competitions. All entrants waive any claims against Arteast and its affiliates concerning their respective rights in the Images submitted in this exhibit.
6. All works of art must be legibly labeled on the back or underside with the artist's name, title of piece, medium, size and price.

7. All works of art will be displayed for the duration not to exceed 60 days. Works may not be removed from the exhibit prior to the end of the 60-day period.
8. The art curator will handle sales: however, cheques will be made out to Arteast for the price of the artwork. If applicable, provincial tax should be included in the price.
9. It will be at the art curator's discretion for delivering the work to and from the artist or the purchaser.
10. The artist gives permission to Arteast to use images of his or her artwork for promotional purposes, only during the period of the exhibition. Copyright remains with the artists. (Arteast's website features artist of the month.)
