**EXHIBITION RULES:
PLEASE READ CAREFULLY AND THOROUGHLY**

Eligibility: Members of *Arteast*

NEW:

LARGER CANVASES UP TO 48" IN WIDTH WILL NOW BE ACCEPTED UNFRAMED,
EDGES FINISHED IN BLACK OR WHITE OR AS MAY SUIT THE PIECE

1. Size limit: for two-dimensional work up to, 30" in width must be framed unless gallery canvas is used. For three dimensional work, 12" x 12" x 36" *
2. The works submitted must conform to the theme.
3. All works must be original in content, not produced under instruction, not derived from another person's photograph or artwork.
4. Maximum: three (3) works per artist, although only one or two may be selected if space does not permit.
5. PRESENTATION OF WORKS: all entries must be clean, dry, appropriate gauge wire with sturdy hardware (D-rings, C-rings) and the surface protected, if the medium requires this precaution. Works that do not meet with these criteria will not be presented to jurors. This will be enforced.
6. All artworks must be identified on the back of the work with the name of the artist, the title and the price
7. A non-refundable entry fee of \$5.00 per artwork is collected at drop-off time (cheque or cash, NO coins).
8. The completed application form must include "exhibition volunteer duties" and be accompanied by the total entry fee and the membership fee to *Arteast*, if applicable. Cheque or Money Order shall be made payable to *Arteast*.
9. *Arteast* is run by volunteers, it relies on the active support of its members; all participants will be called upon to assist with the exhibition. Every effort will be made to accommodate your volunteer preference, however, you may be asked to take part in another activity, if needed.
10. Sales will be coordinated with the artist and the City of Ottawa Gallery Coordinator. A 25% commission, payable to *Arteast* is to be forwarded to the Treasurer, Dorothy Zorn, 2026 New Carlisle Crescent, Orléans, K4A 4M1 at the time of purchase. 10% of this commission goes to *Arteast* and 15% goes to the Shenkman Arts Centre endowment fund.
11. Works must be for sale and sold as entered. The City may use images of your artwork submitted for the exhibition for promotional purposes. The use of such will not be subject to copyright or other legislations.
12. No changes in artwork title or price will be made from that shown on the application form. Members wishing their titles to appear in both languages must provide both titles on the application form and do their own translation.
13. Results of the jurying will be provided to the participants within a week of the jurying. Only results to be provided will either be "in the exhibition" or "not in the exhibition". No further feedback will be given nor will results be shared at time of pick-up.
14. Works must not be removed before the end of the exhibition. The protocol for everyone participating in this exhibition is to pick up their work at the appointed time or have someone else do it for them.
15. Although the gallery may be staffed during certain times, entry is at the participant's own risk. The exhibitor is strongly urged to cover his/her artwork(s) against risks of loss or damage by obtaining proper insurance.

16. A late pick-up and/or storage requirement will be charged at \$15.00 per day, per piece, and payable to *Arteast*. There will be no exceptions.
